For the upcoming sailing season, Sea Ranger Service is looking for crew members for operations in the UK/Celtic Sea. For the position of Rating Deck, we are seeking a motivated individual with a passion for our mission and working with young, inexperienced people. Someone who creates a positive learning environment, listens well, and is approachable.

What will you be doing?

In this role, you are part of the navigational watch. Your main focus is guiding Sea Rangers in learning to sail and executing assignments. You are responsible for safe navigation, trip planning, and ensuring the transfer of your knowledge to the Sea Rangers. Additionally, you actively participate in the execution of tasks and maintenance work. You work hands-on in the operation to ensure that the team makes the necessary impact. In this position, you report to the Captain, and your hierarchical supervisor is the Head of Operations.

Your tasks include

- You independently carry out orders from the Captain and First Mate
- Under the guidance of the Captain and/or First Mate, you independently perform navigation and trip planning with the Sea Rangers
- You are part of the navigational watch
- You guide and support Sea Rangers in executing assignments, progressing through the curriculum, and working within various departments on board
- You carry out assignments for our clients at sea
- You actively contribute to the safe operation of our sailing ship
- You conduct maintenance on the ship, research, communication, and measurement equipment
- You are an ambassador for ensuring our culture and safety

About the Sea Ranger Service

The Sea Ranger Service is the world's first maritime ranger service. Our mission is to restore 1 million hectares of nature at sea and train 20,000 young people to start a maritime career. For this training, young people join us as Sea Rangers, a job where they work on nature restoration

- You have your seafarer's endorsement Rating Deck forming part of a navigational watch (II/4)
- You possess a valid medical examination for shipping as a seafarer with lookout or watch function on the bridge and/or engine room
- You have a seaman's book
- You speak and write fluent Dutch and English; both languages are actively used within our organisation
- You have a valid EU passport or ID card

You enjoy supporting people in their development and are a good listener. Finally, you are empathetic and can collaborate effectively with different kinds of people.
